- Have uniformity of delivery of the SAV support services
- Deliver vocational opportunities and outcomes for Survivors and Carers

SUSTAINABILITY

- Have a Committee of Management (CoM) for each centre with an SAV Board Member appointed and active in each CoM
- Drive community awareness opportunities around each of our support centres
- Have a Will2Walk fundraising event in each region that has a centre
- Achieve government financial support
- Achieve corporate funding support

INFORMATION & DATA

- Accurately capture relevant data on stroke survivors and carers, their participation and recovery through SAV activities
- Have information material in every hospital in Victoria
- Have information material in every GP practice in Victoria

GOVERNANCE & LEADERSHIP

- Ensure strong leadership and good governance through a skills-based board and local committees of management for each support centre
- Contribute to ongoing stroke recovery research
- Continue and grow the annual stroke forum in Melbourne each year
